
'By day, we were at school learning logarithms, but by night – in the back of cars, down behind the Ace-of-Spades Hotel and on Cronulla Beach – we put on our friendship masks. *Puberty Blues* is about adolescence – and the irrelevance of high school and adults to their real world. The rules and the bonds make up their real world. The rules are tough, initiation essential and approval by the top chicks and sputniks is all that counts.'

Kathy Lette and Gabrielle Carey's account of adolescence is horrifying yet hilarious. It will appal the conservative and will offend those who are instrumentalizing the young. It will jog well-meaning adults into a re-examination of the ways they attempt to protect young people from themselves. It should be welcomed by those who have been seeking to set up a dialogue between the generations.

*Puberty Blues* gives us the facts no one wants to face. It is a deadly accurate account of the way many young people live, and some of them die. Or at best survive.

A workshop and activity based studio engagement between the student (cohort of 192) and the building experimenting with sustainable media and techniques. Digital image capture of experience and process is key.


